The *Come, Follow Me* program has been a great blessing to our family. Some of our most effective weeks have come when we teach our children the stories from the Book of Mormon throughout the week, then have our children teach those same stories back to us on Sunday for Family Home Evening.

One of our favorite examples of our children teaching us was the story of Alma and Amulek in the prison. On their own, they spent a Sunday afternoon making puppets and preparing a detailed puppet show. We were very surprised at the accuracy of their story re-telling. Often, we don't feel like they are listening or that our efforts are making a difference, but moments like this show us that they are learning!

We have also been impressed by how frequently the lessons from the scriptures have come up in the challenges we face as a family. The story in 3 Nephi 3 when all of the Nephites left their homes and uprooted their lives to gather in Zarahemla and Bountiful to defend themselves against the Gadianton Robbers helped our children to process the upheaval and disappointment they have experienced this year with so many canceled plans, events, and vacations. If the Nephites could do it (for up to 7 years!), we can get through this year!
