2023 Curriculum to Focus on New Testament

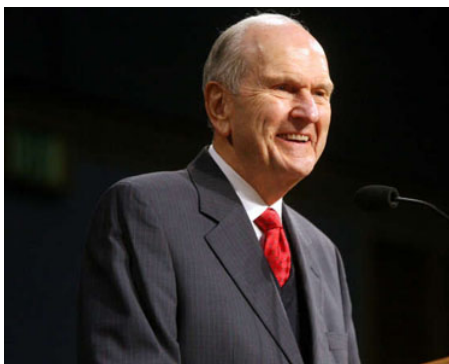
